GRANT REQUEST POLICY AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

1. It is the policy of the Son's of Italy, Monterey Lodge 2003, that in order for our membership to consider providing grants, a request must be made in writing. Request for grants will be accepted from Monterey, Pacific Grove, Seaside, Marina and Carmel, CA. The amount of the grant will be determined by the Son's of Italy Grant Committee.
2. The Son's of Italy, Monterey Lodge 2003, will accept grant requests on an ongoing basis. We do not provide standardized forms of application however, it is preferred that each grant request should be a request in its own written form, which must include the following information:
 - Full name of organization, street address, city and state, and telephone number.
 - The names of all officers and directors.
 - A brief description of present activities and objectives.
 - The amount of monetary help requested and a detailed description of the project.
 - The intended use of the grant.
 - Information about the organization.
3. The Son's of Italy, Monterey Lodge Grant Committee will review all grant request and supporting documents to determine whether they fall within areas of interest and current funding priorities. Those grant requests that meet the criteria listed above will be subject to further review and investigation prior to final approval.
4. It should be noted that the present policy of the Son's of Italy, Monterey Lodge 2003, declines to consider request for grants:
 - To Individuals other than scholarships (separate applications exist for scholarship programs)
 - To national or large campaigns
 - To contribute to the cost of seminars, workshops, conferences and informational tours
 - To make-up operating deficits
 - To governmental agencies and foreign countries
 - For any propaganda, political or otherwise, attempting to influence legislation in any way
 - The advancement of religious groups and denominations
 - Endowments

5. The Son's of Italy, Monterey Lodge 2003, Grant Committee, will make every effort to fund as many grant requests that are feasible and within budgetary guidelines. Grant size will vary based on funds available and the Son's of Italy Grant Committee will determine priorities based on need.
6. Grant requests that do not contain all of the requested information may not be considered.
